Advanced Research Methodology Course (ARM) Combined Presentation (Batch 2021-22 and 2022-23)

All research scholars, who were admitted to PhD Programme of the Department of History in 2021-22 and 2022-23 batch, are hereby informed that the ARM Presentation is scheduled to take place around **mid-February 2024**.

As per the requirement of PhD Ordinance 2017, there will be a presentation of term papers arising from the ARM Course completed by the PhD scholars enrolled in 2021-22 and 2022-23 batches.

Each PhD scholar is expected to make a 15-minute presentation, which will be followed by a 15-minute discussion.

The presentation should emerge from the PhD course(s) that the research students have completed and can be on any range of subjects that you have discussed with your supervisor and research advisory committee members. It could, for example, communicate your thoughts on the history and historiography of your research subject. The exercise is expected to hone your presentation skills and provide an early opportunity to discuss your research projects with your peers.

These presentations will not be graded; however, they are mandatory for every PhD scholar. The supervisors and research advisory committee members of the respective students are expected to be present during the presentation.

This is a mandatory requirement, which you must fulfil in order to proceed with your dissertation writing.

The research scholars of the 2020-21 batch, who were not able to make their ARM presentation held in 2022, should submit an application in the office before 15^{th} January 2024 duly forwarded by the supervisor.

The dates with detailed schedule of the presentations would be notified very soon.
