Advanced Research Methodology Course (ARM) Combined Presentation (Batch 2022-23)

All research scholars admitted to the PhD Programme of the Department of History in the 2022-23 batch are hereby informed that the ARM Presentation is scheduled for 5th, 6th, and 8th August 2024.

As per the requirement of the PhD Ordinance 2017, each PhD scholar must present a term paper derived from the ARM Course. Each scholar is allotted a 15-minute presentation slot, followed by a 15-minute discussion.

The presentation should emerge from the PhD course(s) that the research students have completed and can be on any range of subjects that you have discussed with your supervisor and research advisory committee members. It could, for example, communicate your thoughts on the history and historiography of your research topic. The exercise is intended to hone your presentation skills and provide an early opportunity to discuss your research projects with your peers.

While these presentations will not be graded, attendance and participation are mandatory for every PhD scholar. Supervisors and research advisory committee members are expected to attend their respective students' presentations. Completing this requirement is essential to proceed with your dissertation writing phase.

Research scholars who missed the earlier ARM presentation must apply at the office before 20th July 2024, with their application duly forwarded by their supervisor.

The detailed schedule of presentations will be notified by the end of July 2024.
