Notice for PhD Admissions, 2025-26 Phase-II


Eligibility for Ph.D. Admission (2025–26, Phase II):

Candidates are eligible to appear for the interviews in accordance with the following:

- University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, dated 7 November 2022.
- University of Delhi Ordinance VI (Amendment to the Procedure for Award of M.Phil. and Ph.D. Degrees), dated September 2023.
- Eligibility criteria specified in the Bulletin of Information dated 17.10.2025 and the Information Brochure dated 10.03.2026, available at: <https://admission.uod.ac.in/>
Candidates will be considered eligible for the interview only upon successful submission of their application through the University admission portal, along with all required documents, including a research proposal.

Number of Seats:

Total number of seats available in PhD Program, 2025-26 Phase-II.



A total of 19 seats are available, along with 3 supernumerary seats. Additional seats are also reserved for teaching and non-teaching staff of the University of Delhi, as per university norms.

1. It is compulsory to register on the University portal as per the admission schedule notified by the University: <https://phd-ph2-2025.uod.ac.in/>
2. It is also mandatory to upload a research proposal along with relevant documents on the portal. The proposal and documents uploaded will be treated as final.
3. Proposals for the Ph.D. programme must follow the attached guidelines.
4. Proposals submitted in Hindi must be in Unicode font only.
5. The interviews will be conducted in physical mode at the Department of History, University of Delhi, from 30 March to 04 April 2026, in morning and afternoon sessions. The final interview schedule will be displayed on the Department website (<http://history.du.ac.in/>).
6. Candidates must bring eleven hard copies of their proposals on the day of the interview.
7. Refer to the Bulletin of Information (see Annexure II for Ordinance VI of the University).
